The costs for the implementation of the BT GO system are covered like the electricity system by fees. The maximum fees per transaction are set out in the Regulation on the Fees and Supervisory Tasks in the Energy Sector. The Swiss Federal Office of Energy (SFOE) determines the effective fees to be levied for the following year. The following fees will be charged for the implementation of the BT GO system in 2026:
